

Certified Protection Professional (CPP®) Distance Learning Study Programme

Why this course

The Certified Protection Professional (CPP®) credential provides demonstrable proof of knowledge and management skills in eight key domains of security. Those who earn the CPP® are ASIS board-certified in security management. The CPP® designation is one of the most widely recognised security management qualifications in the world, providing employers with proof of the holder's advanced knowledge of security management. Research from ASIS International consistently confirms that the CPP® enhances career prospects.

The examination is difficult to pass without guided preparation. This course provides a complete learning package combining structured distance learning and a classroom course in Oxfordshire, UK, to prepare candidates for the examination.



Who will benefit

The CPP® certification is designed for security managers and consultants who want an internationally-recognised advanced-level credential in security management.

The ARC Programme Includes

- An orientation session – the Trainer runs a conference call during which he explains the timetable of study and approach required of delegates. He also covers FAQs and lessons learned by previous attendees.
- A guided four month distance learning programme, comprising mandatory monthly tasks. These are designed to familiarise delegates with the Protection of Assets (POA) Domains and also the relevant ASIS Standards and Guidelines. Detailed feedback is given after each task.
- A five-day intensive and interactive non-residential classroom course. This is designed to explain, consolidate and discuss the POA Domains and to test delegate knowledge, as well as pinpoint where further personal revision should be concentrated.

The examination fee, the set reading materials and accommodation during the classroom course are not included in the ARC study package fee. Details of reading materials can be found on the ASIS website.

Applying for the CPP® Certification Exam

Qualification is by computer-based examination which costs \$300 for ASIS members and \$450 for non-members. Application to sit the examination should be made directly through ASIS International via the ASIS website.

The examination is conducted by ASIS International at a number of Prometric test centres around the UK and internationally. Prospective candidates are responsible for checking their eligibility to sit the examination and for registering directly with ASIS International, as well as for booking their exam directly with their preferred Prometric test centre.
