- Bachelor's degree or higher and four years of progressive physical security experience.

About The Exam

The exam consists of 125 multiple-choice questions and may also contain 15 "pre-test" (unscored) questions randomly distributed throughout the examination, for a total of 140 questions. The time allowed takes into consideration review of pre-test items. The exam covers tasks, knowledge and skills in three broad domains that have been identified by Physical Security Professionals as the major areas involved in physical security management.
